## STARTERS MENU

**In this area, write a list of 5-10 homework ideas for a key stage, project or year group. The set of homework listed here should be achievable and based on prior knowledge.**

Add success criteria; a simple statement describing how each homework will be assessed and what is needed.

Make sure each homework can be read there and then, and works as an instant 'Takeaway'. This means, it requires no further guidance.

## Assessment/Reward Criteria

This area should include marking and assessment. How will each piece of homework be assessed? This could be displayed with a grading/marketing code alongside each homework statement. An indication of timeframe, website links and possible rewards.

## MAIN DISH MENU

**In this area, write a list of 5-10 homework ideas. The set of homework listed here should be achievable – with effort.**

Students will be required to complete additional work, regardless of what has/has not taken place in the classroom.

## Buffet Menu

The buffet menu provides a range of specific choices for some students to choose from providing a more limited choice within the entire menu. The star icon indicates the choices available to them, with instructions provided here.



## DESSERT MENU

**In this area, write a list of 5-10 homework ideas. The set of homework listed here should be a difficult to achieve, but also enticing to try.**

Students will be required to complete a great deal of hard work outside of the classroom. Struggle should be expected, but the rewards should be high.

## Menu-o-meter

The Menu-o-meter is the key to explain all the homework available.

A clock icon indicates time task will take (30 mins per clock).



A chili indicates the homework is difficult (3 chillies – very hard!).



The pepper colour indicates the homework is differentiated.
